

Zoo Atlanta Virtual Programming Code of Conduct



Thank you for signing up to join our virtual programming. To ensure that all participants have a safe and enjoyable experience, we ask all parents/legal guardians and participants to review this Code of Conduct prior to the start of your program. Please be advised that if we find any participant in violation of this Code of Conduct, we reserve the right to remove the participant from the program without refund. We may additionally report any violations to the participant's parent/legal guardian or law enforcement.

1. Disorderly Conduct

Participants are expected to show common courtesy for other participants and staff by not using profanity or engaging in disruptive or offensive behavior. Zoo Atlanta prohibits behaviors that are disruptive or disrespectful of others. This includes, but is not limited to, bullying or combative conduct, harassing or derogatory language, excessive noise and setting inappropriate background images in connection with one's virtual programming platform account.

2. Recordings and Photographs

Zoo Atlanta prohibits any recording and photographs of virtual programming without the prior written permission of the program director.

3. Meeting Restrictions

Zoo Atlanta prohibits sharing of meeting information (e.g. Zoom link) with anyone who is not a registered participant of the program, and inviting of anyone who is not registered for the program or who is not authorized in writing by program staff to participate in virtual programming. Unregistered individuals (e.g. siblings, friends) cannot accompany participants in the virtual programming.

4. Communications with Program Staff

Zoo Atlanta prohibits communications between participants and program staff outside of program-related business and official communication channels such as Zoo Atlanta's Zoom account or Zoo Atlanta's email. Zoo Atlanta discourages participants from following program staff on any social media platform or exchanging any personal contact information.
